Routes through the Northwest Passage took almost 400 years to find




# Europeans saw locals as "Pagans"



#### Faith Reliance: Addressing issues to encourage being part of Church multiplication:

- Freedom from foreign funding in "funding mix" as equal participants in the Great Commission
- Believers are taught biblical concepts of generous giving along with discipling
- Model integrity; avoid corruption and "double dipping": use transparent and public accounting methods
- Local ministries use culturally adapted biblical fundraising



#### Other issues that can prevent us

## Missionaries: Even great Foreign Missionaries ...

- Sometimes have a "saviour" mentality that does not allow local leadership to grow (LT)
- Sometimes work from their own agenda rather than the vision of the local church
- Sometimes lack an "exit strategy" for foreign involvement or know if they should have one

## James 1: 9-11

#### Dream for God's gracious guidance!


### Forward motion, together, in the Expedition
